Please be aware of the Fonda Fair policy regarding parking.

**A detailed schedule for the 4-H Poultry Show & the 4-H Rabbit & Cavy Show will be sent to all exhibitors before the fair to plan appropriately.

Parking passes will only be available to large animal exhibitors. Small Animal (poultry, rabbit, cavy) & Non-Animal Exhibitors will not receive a parking pass. Parking is \$5 per day. Please plan accordingly.





4-H Entry Card

Pictured below is the 4-H entry card that must be securely attached to each (non-animal) 4-H exhibit/ project which is entered in the 4-H building. On Non-Animal Judging Day (Saturday, August 23) all exhibits are to be brought to the 4-H building to be judged one-on-one with 4-Hers. Entry cards are distributed when entries are delivered to the 4-H office. If you mailed, emailed or faxed your entries, cards are available to be picked-up at the 4-H Office.

NEW THIS YEAR: Fillable pdf entry cards. If you choose this method, you must print your own entry cards on white card stock. Entry cards printed on regular paper will not be accepted. Hole punch and paper perforator will be available at check-in on Non-Animal judging day.

We highly encourage youth complete entry cards before Non-Animal judging day.

These entry cards are not required for Rabbits, Poultry, Livestock & Horses. Animal Exhibit Cards will be distributed at the 4-H Animal Exhibitor Meeting on Tuesday, August 26 at 7pm in the Ag2000 Building.

NEW THIS YEAR: Fillable pdf animal exhibit cards. If you choose this method, you must print your own entry cards on white card stock. Entry cards printed on regular paper will not be accepted.

HERDSMANSHIP & STABLE MANAGEMENT

(only applicable to youth showing Dairy Cattle, Beef Cattle, Swine, Sheep, Dairy Goats, Meat & All Other Goats & Horses)

HERDSMANSHIP CRITERIA - Each Section is graded 0 - 5: 0 being the lowest and 5 being the highest

Alley & Isles - Alley and public area are to be clean and neat; Hay/feed/tack neat & orderly; Wheelbarrow clean and out of the way.

Stalls & Animals - Stalls, Bedding, Animals and Exhibit are to be clean and neat.

Display - UPDATE for 2025 - 4-H Animal Exhibit Cards are mandatory to use in stall decorations for each

<u>animal entered in 4-H</u>. Decorations are to be neat and attractive, display must include some form of educational component to educate the general public on your given animal science project. Could include breed association educational materials and more!

Note: If your 4-H exhibit card is eaten, missing or destroyed, please ask Kyle for a replacement 4-H animal exhibit card.

4-H animal exhibit card suffices the 4-H clover requirement in your display. If you do not have your exhibit clearly labeled, herdsmanship/stable management judges will not be able to judge your exhibit and the score will be a 0 for that time frame.

Judging will occur ONCE daily between 9am-5pm Ag2000 Building, Cow Palace and the Horse barns.


