Rules and Regulations:

- ****NEW** No day of show entries will be accepted for the 2019 show.**
- Pre-entries with payment must be submitted to the 4-H Office by 4:30pm on Friday, June 7th, 2019. Only class additions to existing pre-entries will be allowed. Classes must be entered at least two classes in advance on show day.
- Entry fees: \$35 for whole day, \$5 for Cloverbud whole day, \$25 for one division (Western, English/Jumping, Walk/Trot/Jog), or \$5.00 per class. **Refunds will only be given if person or horse is injured.** Fitting and Showmanship and Trail are included in the price for any division.
- **There is a mandatory \$7.00 grounds fee for all participants.**
- Please include proof of Coggins (within the past two calendar years) and Rabies with your entry.
- One entry per class per rider and one number per horse/rider combination.
- Alternate gated horses will be allowed to compete in all classes.
- 4-H approved helmets are MANDATORY and appropriate footwear - no "fat baby boots".
- Cloverbud 4-H members may ride in lead line or Cloverbud walk/trot/jog, participation ribbon only.
- The youth and horse combination must have a passed and signed riding and/or driving evaluation on file with the 4-H Office.. Out of counties youth will be required to show proof of evaluation. Note: Fulton-Montgomery 4-H requires that evaluations are on the youth and horse combination.
- Grand & Reserve Champion English, Western, Western Walk/Jog, English Walk /Trot & Miniature Horse will be given.
- The show will be run by the rules as listed in the "New York State 4-H Rulebook".
- All participants must sign the acknowledgement of risk form, participant agreement and show a current 4-H Horse Certificate as proof of 4-H Horse Project and proof of evaluation at current riding level from your county 4-H office.
- **The show committee and/or 4-H Educator reserves the right to add, combine, or cancel any classes.**
- In consultation with the judge, the show committee and/or 4-H Educator reserves the right to limit or eliminate the exhibition of lame or over- run horses at this show.
- **All contestants must show in one Fitting and Showmanship class.**
