Important Changes to the New York State
4-H Membership Policy



****Membership age NOT determined by school grade****

- Youth who are five years of age, on or before January 1 of the current club year, may enroll as a 4-H Cloverbud member.
- Youth who are eight years of age, on or before January 1 of the current club year, may enroll as a 4-H member.
- Youth who turn nineteen years of age, on or before January 1 of the current club year, *may not* enroll as a 4-H member.

4-H End of the Year Completion Check List:



- Complete a 4-H Project Record Book:** Every 4-H member needs to complete one to receive his/her Fonda Fair premium check and to be eligible for awards on Recognition Night! Due to the office by October 15th.
- Complete an Animal Record Sheet:** Required if 4-Her completed an animal project during last year. There is a new form in this month's 4-H newsletter, if you have already completed the older version you may use it for this year. Due to the 4-H office by October 15th with Record Book. Available on p. 5 and 6 of this newsletter.

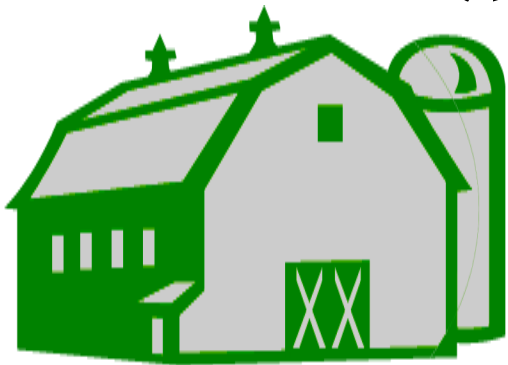

ROCKETS TO THE RESCUE

Join millions of other 4-H youth as they become scientists for the day on October 8th. This fun experiment can be done in your club or on your own. The University of Arizona developed the 2014 National Science Experiment, Rockets to the Rescue!, which explores the field of aerospace engineering.
